#### **Teaching routines:**

- Mrs Follows and Mrs Gallagher will be our Teaching Assistants for this year, working with groups of children at any time to ensure essential progress is achieved.
- On a Monday afternoon, each class will have an outdoor PE session taught by a sports coach, a music lesson taught by Mrs Walkinshaw or an RE lesson taught by Mrs Follows (HLTA).



#### Homework

- Homework is usually an extension or consolidation of work that has been done in class and in Year 6.
- It will become an increasingly valuable tool for revision and SATs preparation.
- Maths will be given out on a Tuesday and is due back in on Friday.
- English will be given out on Friday and is due back in on a Tuesday.
- Please feel free to comment in your child's reading record on how your child has found the homework tasks.



#### **Reading:**

- It is essential that children bring their reading books to school each day.
- An adult will listen to your child read within a guided reading session each week.
- Guided reading will be a taught session and will use a book of a higher level to provide more challenge.
- Children will also have the opportunity to change their individual reading books throughout the week.
- Please support your child by encouraging them to read on a daily basis, for a minimum of 20 minutes 5 times a week, and signing their Reading Record on a weekly basis.



#### PE and Games:

- Outdoor PE kit is required on a Monday (children will come to school in their kit)
- A spare pair of trainers would be useful to have in school and kept in lockers
- Please ensure your child has the correct PE kit.

- Information will be sent home via e-mail, text, Class Dojo and/or letter.
- If you want to speak to your child's Class Teacher personally or need to discuss a matter at length then please contact school in the usual way to request an appointment at a mutually convenient time.
